This year, Children in Need will be held on Friday 14th November. We are inviting the children who come to nursery on this day to come to school in their pajamas!

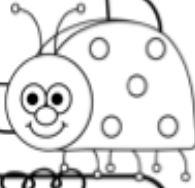
Please send in a small donation, which we will collect and send off from the Nursery.
